Landscape Snip-n-Drip Soaker System

Water up to 10 trees, shrubs or perennial plantings with our Landscape Snip-n-Drip Soaker System. Apply water just where you need it, not where you don't!

Parts Included

100' Black Soaker Hose
50' Green Garden Hose

Tools Needed

Sharp scissors



Assembly

Step 1. Unroll the Black Soaker Hose and Green Garden Hose and lay them in the sun to increase flexibility.

Step 2. Attach the Quick-Connect with Coupler to the 25' Green Garden Hose. Unscrew the threaded cap from the rounded end of the coupler and slide the cap over one end of the hose. Push the end of the hose firmly into the exposed end of the adapter until it stops. Slide the cap over the threads of the adapter and twist it firmly into place (Figure 1).

Step 3. Screw the Pressure Regulator onto your faucet. Screw the Faucet Adapter either directly onto the Pressure Regulator or onto a hose that you then attach to the Pressure Regulator. Connect the Green Garden Hose to your water supply by snapping the Faucet Adapter into the Quick-Connect Coupler.

Step 4. Run the Green Garden Hose to the first plant you want to water. Cut to length. Attach the hose to one side of a Hose Coupler, following the instructions in Step 2.

Step 5. Attach the Black Soaker Hose to the other side of the Hose Coupler. Loop the soaker hose around the drip line of the plant and cut it to length. The drip line is the outside edge of a plant's foliage where rainfall would naturally drip to the ground. Most of the plant's roots are within this zone.

Step 6. Attach another Hose Coupler to the end of the Soaker Hose loop, then attach the Green Garden Hose. Extend the garden hose to the next plant and repeat Steps 4 and 5. Continue adding up to 10 loops to your system.

Step 7. At the end of the system, attach the End Cap with Coupler to the last piece of Soaker Hose.

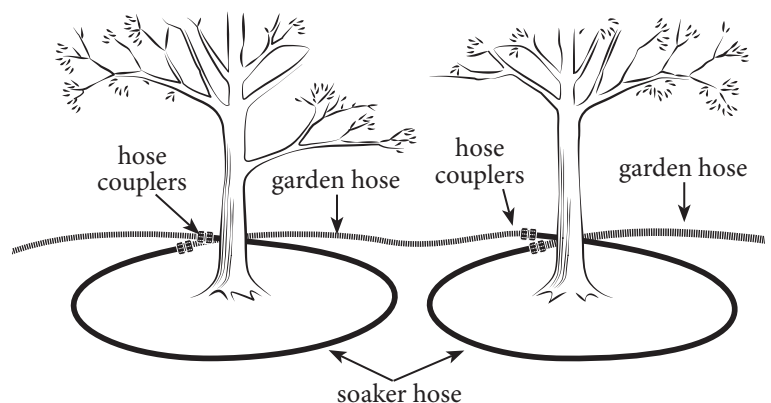
Step 8. Turn on the water source and adjust the pressure so that water drips gently from the soaker hose without spraying. Assembly is complete!

Tips for Use

- Hold the hoses and fittings in place with optional Earth Staples or Easy Out Earth Staples.
- Adjust the water pressure at the faucet so that the water drips from the soaker hose without spraying.
- Drain the soaker system prior to freezing weather to prevent hose splitting. The system may be left in place for the winter after draining.
- Add an optional water timer to automatically water your landscape.
